ENGR 4306	ENGR Internship – 1: Internship opportunity provides experience in the practice of engineering for undergraduate students. Its purpose is engineering career development.	3:3:0
ENGR 4307	ENGR Internship – 2: Internship opportunity provides experience in the practice of engineering for undergraduate students. Its purpose is engineering career development.	3:3:0
ENGR 5306	ENGR Internship – 1: Internship opportunity provides experience in the practice of engineering for graduate students. Its purpose is engineering career development.	3:3:0
ENGR 5307	ENGR Internship – 2: Internship opportunity provides experience in the practice of engineering for graduate students. Its purpose is engineering career development.	3:3:0
BUSI 5360	Internship – Using an outside organization or one of the learning institutes within the College, the student must submit a paper with an analysis of their experiential learning, prepare an industry bibliography and write a paper summarizing the tasks and accomplishments encountered within the organization.	3:3:0
COSC 5360	Internship I – This course provides practical experience with a company engaged in work related to a career in computer science. The purpose is career development before graduation. The course requires that the student obtain permission for CPT from the International Service Office. <i>Prerequisite: Approval of department chair.</i>	3:3:0
