Lichen Ma was born in Xian, China and naturalized as a US citizen in 1973. He has earned both B.S. in agricultural economics and M.S. in rural sociology from National Taiwan University, and Ph.D. in sociology from University of Georgia. Presently he is professor of sociology and Chair of Department of Sociology, Social Work and Criminal Justice at Lamar University. During his tenure at Lamar, he has taught: Introduction to Sociology, Urban Sociology, Medical Sociology, Population Problems, Research Methods, Social Theory, American Society, and Chinese Society. He guest-lectured at several universities in Taiwan and China and has held visiting professorships from National Taiwan University (Taipei, Taiwan), Heilongjiang University (Harbin), and Oriental University (Harbin), and consultative professorships from Huazhong University of Science and Technology (Wuhan), and Harbin Normal University (Harbin). Dr. Ma specializes in demography, research methods, and comparative American- Chinese societies. He has published more than 40 articles in sociological and psychological journals, including Journal of Social Psychology, Journal of Psychology, Psychological Reports, Sociological Spectrum, Free Inquiry in Creative Sociology, and presented more than 40 papers at sociological conferences. Furthermore, he has received a number of competitive research grants.
